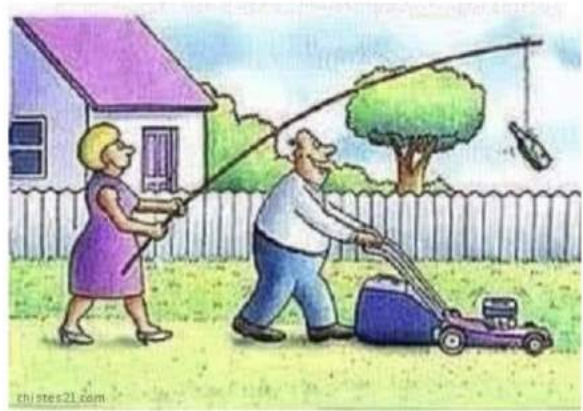

Gardening Tip

It's not too early to prepare for your winter veggie garden whilst the soil is warm. Brussel sprouts and broccoli can be planted now. Aerate and turn your compost heap regularly.

On the flip side, it's not too late to put in a late summer crop of tomatoes, cucumbers and lettuce.

Even though we've had a deluge of rain, make sure to keep up the watering on your vegetables. If your tomatoes are allowed to dry out, they risk getting blossom end rot.



ZERO WASTE / RECYCLING

A few lines to inspire people to tread lightly on this beautiful planet

PLASTIC #1 – now that we've got our recycling bins I sometimes wonder what plastic can actually go in it. So I had a look on a couple of websites and thought I might share some information about all the numbers.



Water, soft drink and sport drink bottles, condiment bottles, peanut butter, vegemite and jam jars. - These items are a rigid/hard plastic, they can be recycled through your recycling bin. **However if you can, avoid purchasing plastic bottles and choose to use re-usable, refillable or glass bottles instead.** (whichbin.sa.gov.au)

Recycled PET can be used to manufacture new bottles and containers, thermoform packaging, strapping and is also used in fibre applications such as carpet.

And again, please don't put glass jars or wine bottles in the recycling bin, as these can break in the compaction truck and contaminate all other recycling, which then might end up at the dump. You can recycle them along with your \$0.10 recycling, or of course re-use.

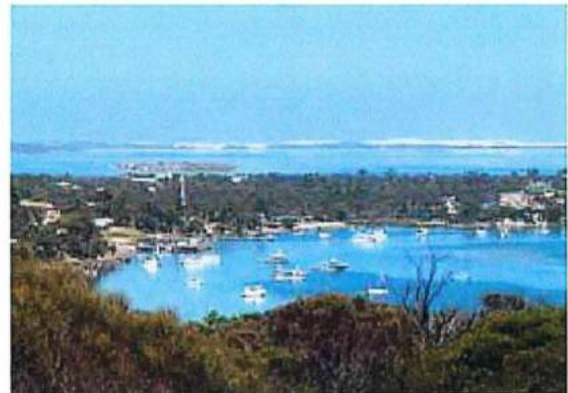
