



- Diving only in designated areas, no bombers or somersaults.
- 11. Respectful behaviour required, no harassment or discrimination tolerated.
- 12. Trespassers will be prosecuted.

\$1.88M POOL REDEVELOPMENT

The Cummins and District War Memorial Swimming Pool is now open for the 2023/24 season. However for the pool to remain functional beyond this season, a \$1.88m redevelopment is being planned.

A significant part of the redevelopment is raising the money needed for this to happen. Did you know that the Cummins pool is a community pool run by a volunteer committee? There is also now a redevelopment committee, working alongside the operational committee, to source the funding that is needed to secure the future of the pool and manage the redevelopment process.

We are thankful to so far have been successful in the following funding:

- \$50,000 from the Lower Eyre Council
- \$250,000 from the Cummins Community Hotel
- \$5,000 from the Unity Op Shop
- \$5,000 from a Nutrien Ag Grant through FRRR
- \$2,500 from the IGA Community Chest

We have other grants pending notification and also plan to soon have a tax-deductible donation program that anyone can donate to. Please keep an eye out for that if you think you can donate to this.



WHAT ARE THE REDEVELOPMENT PLANS?

To keep the pool operational for this regional community, aquatic construction specialists have developed a plan to upgrade pipe, drainage and filtration systems, replace gutters, grates and pool lining and repair corrosion.

In addition to this essential work to keep the pool operational, we are looking to improve accessibility by replacing the defunct toddler pool with a splash pad, removing the lip of each pool, and building an access ramp for the 25m pool.

Works will start in April 2024 if sufficient funding is raised by then.
