



ONCE IN A BLUE MOON



A few days ago, we drove over to the Wangary Pig Farm for breakfast. On the way, we stopped at the NW corner of Kelledie Bay, amazed at the thick blanket of Grey Teal roosting along the water's edge. It was one of the biggest flocks I had ever seen – there were approx. 1,500 ducks! There are invariably a few water birds seen here, but seeing a big flock was a first for me.

The SE corner of Kelledie had always been the favoured area for water birds, so I wondered what had caused the change. Teal ducks need some fresh, or at least, brackish water. Perhaps the springs and soaks there had dried up. I determined to check on the way home.

Coast Care have done a great job rehabilitating the approach to the beach in this SE corner of Kelledie Bay. The spring is a few hundred metres' walk from the car park. On the way, I glimpsed what I thought was a rat scurrying under the low cliff face rock bordering the beach. On stopping and watching, it wasn't a rat, but a very furtive bird about the size of a Murray Magpie. It was reluctant to fly but relied on scampering behind bushes and rocks to avoid detection. A flaw in its camouflage was the constant tail-bobbing which betrayed its hiding places. By stopping stock-still, the bird remained within a range of six metres, so I had a good chance to enjoy it.

Its most striking features were brilliant red eyes and a vivid green beak. I was captivated! I needed to refer to my bird books to Identify that It was an Australian Crake, the first one I had ever seen – a once in a blue moon occasion for me. But I stupidly left my camera in the car, so the picture is one I pinched from a bird book.

Australian Crakes are mostly nomadic, inhabiting the southern half of our continent. They are found near fresh water, especially the Murray Darling region and ephemeral waters such as flood plains and swamps. The freshwater soaks and springs around Kelledie Bay must be why the bird was sighted here. They forage in the damp, feeding on aquatic insects, molluscs, and plant matter.

And yes, the spring and soaks in the SE corner of Kelledie Bay were flowing copiously.
