Cummins Town Garage Sale

This year is the fourth year Cummins has held a Town Garage Sale.

A Cummins Town Map with details about site locations and what goods are for sale will be available to be picked up from the Cummins Hall on Sunday morning from 8:30am. There are 13 house sites in the town offering many bargains, and the Cummins Hall and the RSL Hall have numerous inside stalls adding to the sale. Sales on the day start at 9 am and the sites continue operating until 2:30pm or earlier if all items are sold. The Five Loaves Bakery, Cummins Men's Shed and Community Op Shop will also be open during the day. The Cummins Hotel and Cummins Deli and Takeaway will be open as usual for food and refreshments.
