# 2023/24 - Christmas Holidays - Kerbside Waste & Recycling Collections

Please note the following changes to scheduled collections in some areas over the Christmas period:

### Sleaford / Tulka / Stamford / Hawson / Boston west Collection Route

Kerbside waste collection for Monday 25 December 2023 has been changed to Tuesday 26 December 2023

#### Coffin Bay

Extra kerbside waste (red lid) collections will occur in Coffin Bay during the school holidays on:

- Friday, 29 December 2023
- Friday, 05 January 2024
- Friday, 12 January 2024
- Friday, 19 January 2024

Recycling Collection will remain the same for Coffin Bay except Tuesday 26 December 2024 which has changed to Wednesday 27 December 2024.
