Cummins Doctor Accommodation

Council has facilitated the purchase of a house in Cummins the purpose of accommodation. In addition to a donation from Council, donations of \$100,000 were also received from Cummins & District Financial Services and the Cummins Hotel Community Board. Previously held funds raised by the community have now also been released by the Minister for Health.

To manage the accommodation, a committee has been formed with representatives from the CDFS, Lower Eyre Health Advisory Council and Council, with expressions of interest for two independent community members to join the committee having closed on January 27.

Upcoming playground works

Stan Morgan Reserve and Railwav Cummins Triangle playgrounds will soon upgraded with new playgrounds and soft fall and the existing Coffin Bay Foreshore playground will also be having soft fall installed. Works for these upgrades will start on the weekend of the 4th of February with the Cummins playground being removed and work undertaken on site to prepare for soft fall heights. The Stan Morgan reserve playground will also be removed and prepped around this time with the installer due mid to late February.

The Coffin Bay foreshore playground will be prepared for soft fall last, so shouldn't need to be closed until late February. The contractor installing the soft fall is planning on commencing in late February and it is anticipated all playgrounds will be completed

and re-opened by mid-March (if not before).


