Morgan Reserve improvements

Coffin Bay's Morgan Reserve is set to get a \$80,000 facelift. There are plans to use the funds to install SA Water infrastructure for oval watering, and to keep a store of top soil to improve the surface and health of the oval. New playground equipment and soft-fall will also be installed.

Tulka path finished

The Southern Maintenance have completed the concrete section of the trail. This has been a joint project between the Southern Construction and Maintenance Teams.



Security screening

Security screening equipment is being installed at the Port Lincoln Airport this week. The new screening equipment includes checked and carry on baggage screening and new body scan technology which will bring Port Lincoln Airport in line with metro airports. The new Federal Government regulations requiring screening come into effect at Port Lincoln Airport on July 1 2021 and a tender assessment is currently underway to appoint a screening provider.
