Works are expected to be undertaken on the Coffin Bay Boat Ramp from Tuesday, April 5 to Thursday, April 7. Three lanes will remain open at all times, but please take care as mobile plant will be operating in the area.

Cockatoo Drive

A section of Cockatoo Drive will be closed on Monday and Tuesday, April 4-5 while Downer undertakes work in the area.

The western end of Cockatoo Drive from Panoramic Drive to Flinders Highway will be closed, with traffic to be detoured onto Panoramic Drive and Winters Hill Drive.

Volunteer Emergency Services Fund
