Earwigs are starting to invade our gardens. Keep on top of them by laying a beer trap where you see them in large numbers. Make sure to empty and refill regularly.

A good way to attract the bees to pollenate your zucchinis, cucumbers and pumpkins is to leave your brassicas when they start to flower and go to seed. Bees love the yellow flowers.

It is really important to mulch your vege gardens and fruit trees with summer approaching. Watering your citrus is critical during the early summer months.

The community nursing service is recognised as a valuable service for the Coffin Bay community and we will be continuing to provide services Monday, Wednesday and Friday excluding Public Holidays with clients having the choice regarding the location for the delivery of their nursing services, either in the home setting or in a clinic setting.

In response to COVID-19 social distancing requirements a booking-in process has been implemented and Coffin Bay clients can book in and choose to have their services provided either at the clinic or in their home. To book an appointment or make a referral please phone 8683 2200, and ask to speak with the Intake Officer. A nurse will then phone you to discuss a suitable appointment time.

In January 2021 the Coffin Bay Community Nursing clinic-based services will be moving to new premises, utilising clinical consulting rooms at Dr Gerard Quigley's Coffin Bay Practice. The current three-day per week schedule for Coffin Bay providing clinic and in-home nursing services will be maintained.



This initiative is about so much more than re-establishing gardens impacted by fire in SA. These words from Kristy Barnes, founder of SABGR and mental health advocate):


