Gardening Tip

It is an ideal time to improve the health of the soil under your deciduous fruit trees. Mulch the are with aged animal manure. This will be broken down over winter and will show an improvement in the ability of the soil to hold water. Aeration of the soil will be improved as well as better drainage and improved fruit tree nutrients.

I you haven't sprayed your fruit trees yet; time is running out! Drench the trees to prevent fungus spores from growing in cracks and crevices on the branches.

Autumn is a good time to give your strawberries some attention. Remove any late runners and weeds and check for snails. Mulch with cow manure or lucerne pellets. Top off with a seaweed product and liquid organic fertilizer.

ZERO WASTE / RECYCLING

Polypropylene or PP is a **thermoplastic polymer** prized for its resistance to heat, strength, toughness, and flexibility. It is considered one of the safest plastics because it does not leach chemicals.



Ice cream containers and lids, yoghurt, margarine and butter containers, juice bottles, bottle caps, straws, plant pots and plastic takeaway containers.

As a general rule, a quick rinse is more than adequate for plastic containers and bottles. You don't need to scrub the remains in the mayonnaise jar with soap before recycling, and a few spots won't likely hinder the process. If the residue is sticky like peanut butter or honey, you may need to use a scrub brush or scraper to remove more of the product.

Again, small plastic bits like straws and pot plant labels for example, can go in the milk container and be recycled that way.

I am always trying to avoid buying plastic containers. Make my own yogurt, bring plastic containers to the butcher to put my meat in directly. And go to one of the bulk food shops to refill with all the goodies. And while I'm there, get a yummy healthy treat! Guiltfree and delicious

Flinders University Research **Project**

Research scientists from Flinders University have started a major study of water quality in Kellidie and Dutton Bay. The research is funded by grants from the Eyre Peninsula Landscape Board, the Environmental Protection Authority and the District Council of Lower Eyre Peninsula and includes analytical chemists,

hydrogeologists, sedimentologists and marine biologists. The overall aim is to collect data that will help us to understand the condition of the bays and to better manage, improve and protect these environments that are so important to us as a community.

The collection and analysis of water samples from the bays and from groundwater and surface water inflows into the bays is a key part of the research. This includes samples from bores and drains in Coffin Bay town and along the foreshore. If you have a bore on your property and are happy to have samples collected from it please

email your local Councillor Alan Tingay who is assisting the University team – the bore doesn't

have to be in active use.



We listened to you... and we are improving patient care

At Lower Eyre Family Practice we carried out a patient survey (the Practice Accreditation and Improvement Survey) and asked for your honest opinions on the service we provide. We listened to your concerns and have taken the following actions in order to make improvements to patient care, where you feel it would be most useful:

What you told us	What we have done		
1. We could improve the ability for patients to see Doctor or Nurse of choice.	We have been fortunate to recruit Doctor Schroeder-Perrang, to work alongside Dr Quigley and will continue attempting to recruit another Doctor, in order to offer more options and therefore access, for our patient base, to see their Doctor of choice, in a timely manner.		
2. We could improve on updating patients on expected waiting time spent prior to appointment if there are delays	Our reception staff and clinical staff will be communicating more closely with each other when delays occur, so that patients are able to be updated as to how long the delay may be & have the option to reschedule if this goes beyond their ability to wait. We will also try to offer them an appointment with an alternative clinician if their schedule allows & the patient is willing.		
3. We could improve on opportunities for patients to speak to a Clinician on the telephone.	We have introduced telehealth both via telephone and video, so patients are now able to schedule a time with their Doctor and utilise one of these options if they prefer.


