





### Native plant sale & weed ID Coffin Bay Market Sunday August 13 (10am-2.30pm)

A range of local native plants available ready for planting now. \$4 each or 6 for \$20. Bring along in a weed for ID and swap it for a free native plant also giving away free plant to young gardeners.

Some of the plants available for sale include:

€oastal salt bush (Atriplex cinerea) a great addition to your edible bushfood garden Goodia lotifolia a lovely yellow pea flower great for attracting beneficial insects to your garden. Cocky's Tongue (Templetonia retusa) highly ornamental and very hardy plant. Attracts nectar eating birds and native butterflies.

Trees include sheoaks & Pt Lincoln gums

Wattles: great nitrogen fixers for your garden including A.anceps and A. longifolia

Following the good rainfall the last couple of seasons there has been a lot of germination of native plants (and weeds!). Are you unsure about which you have? Bring in a piece of your plant and we will identify it for you.

We are targeting garden plants that become weeds in our coastal bushland particularly along the Oyster Walk. No.1 on the hit list is Polygala, followed by Gazanias, Pink Diosma, Osterospermum daisy, Asparagus fern, Fountain grass, Mirror Bush, Freesias, Dolichos vine, Cotoneaster, African daisy, Italian buckthorn, Boneseed and more (in no particular order).

Come and talk to us and find out if you are growing plants with the potential to "escape" and become weeds in our bushland, and how you can manage them, and what you can grow instead.







### WHIMBREL



Welcome again to the world of migratory shorebirds. The Whimbrel is one of the thirty-six species of shorebirds that fly to the far north of the world to breed. They measure 42cm. in length and have a conspicuous down-curved bill.

May 14th this year was a special day for me. There was a lone Whimbrel on Long Beach - the first one I have ever seen in our area. It was probably a young bird over-wintering, as May is too late in the season to migrate to the arctic tundra to breed. The photo was taken long distance as the subject was camera shy and flew away before I could get closer.

Summer in the tundra only lasts around sixty days. In this time the adult birds court, lay the eggs, and raise their chicks. Late in summer, the parents depart, leaving their brood to fend for themselves. The young gorge themselves on the super abundance of insects and berries, fuelling up for their inaugural flight. With winter imminent, the choice is to stay and freeze, or leave. It is estimated that only 30% of the fledglings survive their maiden flight. The lucky ones remain south for the two years it takes them to attain sexual maturity.

Scientists are discovering that migrating birds are equipped with some truly amazing abilities. They navigate using the sun by day and the stars by night. Very recent research has revealed that they are sensitive to the earth's magnetic field (like a compass needle). So they are still able to find their way even when clouds obscure the sky. A further aid is the facility to alternate sleep from one hemisphere of the brain to the other. The active side takes complete care of navigation and flight while the other side rests.

(Another shorebird, a Bar-tailed Godwit was recorded flying non-stop from Alaska to Tasmania in eleven days, a distance of thirteen and a half thousand kilometres. A truly remarkable feat as shorebirds are poor gliders, so they must continually work their wings to stay airborne).

Whimbrels' long curved beaks are worth a mention. They are equipped with pits holding sensitive nerve endings that can detect and locate underground prey such as crabs, prawns, and worms.

This is just a taste of the remarkable Whimbrels and other migratory shorebirds. But my wonder is mixed with sadness. Because of human factors, ornithologists consider migratory shorebirds to be the most vulnerable of all the classes of birds. It is estimated that some species are only fifteen years away from extinction.


