Warrow Road Update

Drainage works associated with the upgrade of Warrow Road has commenced.

The pavement portion of the upgrade will begin on completion of Bratten Way which is expected during March – April 2024.

Cummins Recyclers Business

Council is excited to announce that it has purchased the Cummins Recyclers Business and are expected to take ownership in February 2024! The Norton family have been providing the recycling service for the last 20 years and Council thank them for allowing us to continue to provide this important service to the Lower Eyre Community.

Arrangements have been made to run the recycling out of the existing Norton Transport / Cummins Recyclers facilities for six months to allow Council to plan and enact any alterations that may be needed to the waste transfer sites to accommodate the recycling business also being at the transfer stations. Commencing from Sunday 4th February, recycling depot hours each week will be:

SANFL, South Australia Government and AFL have partnered to launch South Australian Football Facilities Fund to help create welcoming and football inclusive communities throughout the state.


The total budget for the SA Football Facilities Fund is \$8 million over the course of three years.
