As there is now a vacancy as Councillor, a supplementary election will be held to elect a new member to join the Lower Eyre Council by the Electoral Commission of South Australia.

Nominations open	Thurs 23 May 2024
Nomination close	12 noon, Thurs 6 June 2024
Mailout period	Tues 25 June – Mon 1 July 2024
Returns period	Tues 25 June – 12 noon Mon 22 July 2024
Count	As soon as practicable after close of voting

If you are correctly enrolled for State elections in South Australia, you are automatically included on the Council voters roll and will receive ballot papers through the post.

If you are not enrolled on the State electoral roll, you may be eligible to register on the Council supplementary roll before 5pm, Tuesday 30 April 2024 if you are as follows:

- a resident or a non-Australian citizen who has lived at your residential address for one month or more
- an owner of an organisation or business
- an owner of a holiday home
- a sole owner, or group of owners, of a rateable property
- a sole occupier, or group of occupiers, of a rateable property
- a landlord of rateable property.
