### Grant for Flinders Highway

Council has been successful in a grant application to improve Flinders Highway from the Port Lincoln Golf Club entrance to Wine Shanty Road, including the Pound Lane intersection.

Council will receive \$918,250 – about half the total cost – through the State Government's Local Government Infrastructure Partnership Program.

Work is expected to start in coming months.
