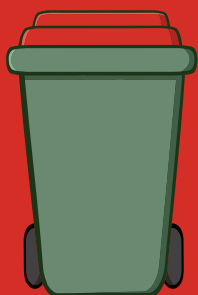

ROLLOUT OF YELLOW RECYCLING BINS

Starting in November 2021 recycling will be coming to the major townships of Cummins, Coffin Bay, Boston, Tiatukia, Tulka, Poonindie, North Shields and Louth Bay.

Council will be providing yellow lid bins to properties in these areas and will be delivered at the end of October.
