Gardening Tip

The soil has worked hard producing summer vegies, so after harvest is finished, replace soil nutrients before replanting. You can do this by adding compost, well-rotted manure, worm castings and organic manure in pellets (from your garden centre).



Powdery mildew on zucchinis is a normal part of the end of the life cycle. A mildew ladybird feeds on it, so there is no need to spray. Discard diseased tomato plants, but zucchini plants can be composted.



Fruit trees don't stop growing simply because their crops have been harvested, as they are busy establishing fruit buds for next season. Unless the nutrients are replaced immediately, the quality and size of next year's crop will be affected. Spread fertiliser blended specifically for fruit crops under the tree's canopy. Make sure it is not applied to dry soil and after spreading, and it is soaked into the top 20 cm of soil.

Hello everyone, I have been reading Phil Siviour's Gardening tips every month and thought I might write about how to maybe inspire people to tread lightly on our beautiful planet. It is something that many of us have been interested in for a while, I'm sure. I came across a book called Six Weeks to Zero Waste written by Kate Arnell and it inspired me to change quite a few things in how I do things. I've been talking about it to my friends and a few of them have asked me questions like "How do I recycle this? Where can I buy this?" so I thought I might share something here once a month.

I am miles away from a Zero Waste lifestyle. Kate Arnell lives in London and has got no children. She can take public transport everywhere and there are many bulk food options in a big city. She even put sausages in her water bottle at the butcher once, because she didn't want to get a plastic bag. Personally, I don't think I'll be shoving anything into my water bottle, but you get the gist, she really does not want to take anything home she potentially has to throw out. But it is nevertheless the first word we'll have to focus on when going about our daily lives: REFUSE. Do I really need this bag to put my new pants in, even if it is a paper bag? Do I need to buy the carrots in a plastic bag or can I put them in my trolley loose? Do I need the free little gift? **What am I going to do with it at home?** That's where I started and it's slowly sinking in. Every day I might make one tiny choice to not contribute to the mountain of waste, and compost instead, recycle paper, aluminium, metal, milk bottles, etc....."We have about a gazillion bins, mum!" my eyerolling teenagers say, but they will still grow up learning about looking after the planet.

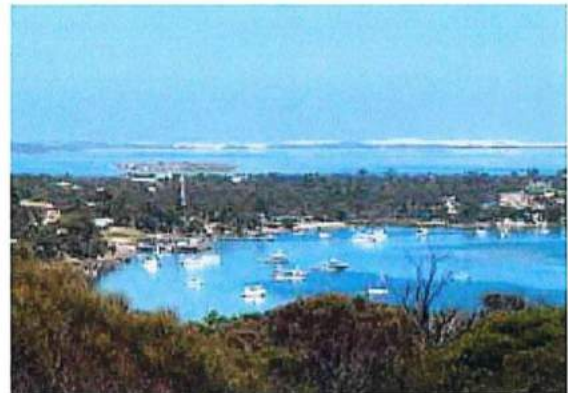

Revenue raised from the store is directed back into the Cummins and District Community. In 2020 the Op Shop donated \$24,000 to the local community.
