COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM

Council has reinvigorated its 2021/22 Community Grants program to offer \$50,000 across three categories for individuals, community and sporting groups.

A new Community Project Grant will consist of broader eligibility criteria than the former Capital Grants program.

The Community Project Grant has a pool of \$43,000 available, with organisations welcome to apply for up to 50 per cent of a total project cost.

An Individual, Educational and Cultural Grant with a \$2000 pool is available to individuals to apply under the following criteria:

- \$100 for events held within South Australia
- \$500 for events held interstate
- \$1,000 for events held internationally

Council has also introduced a Community Halls Support Program, this year worth \$5000.

As part of the program Council will provide a maximum of 75 per cent of a total project cost. Any unallocated funds each year will be allocated to a Community Halls Reserve for future years applications.

Applications close at 12pm on Monday, November 8, 2021.

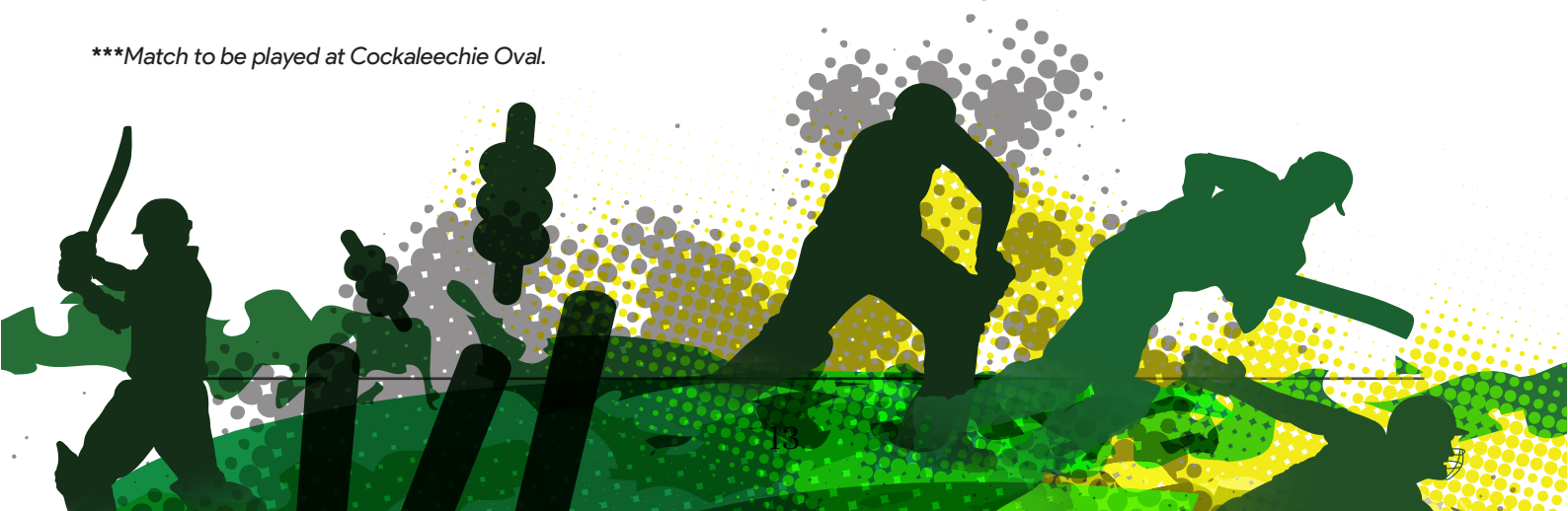

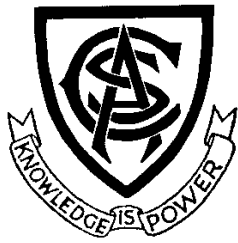

Dear local business owners and families,

The Cummins Area School Preschool & Rural Care Parent Committee are looking to update our Preschool outdoor learning environment. The outdoor area of the Preschool has not had an upgrade since 2008. The existing playspace is very weary looking, aged and has seen many children use this space over the years. A new facility will provide nature play spaces, such as a river pebble channel, insect hotel, stick cubby, musical playboards, tactile playboards, and a tepee, as well as new equipment to enhance the children's gross motor skills such as trampolines, a trinet and rope traverse for preschool children. This will all be inclusive to those with special needs.

The project will further align with the Preschool Early Years Learning framework program. Outdoor play is a fundamental part of a child's development and the provisions of such areas have the ability to create a sense of wonder, generate curiosity, and spark the imagination of young learners. The improvement to our tired area of play will improve the physical, educational and mental wellbeing of preschoolers. It will inspire respect for nature, while allowing a safe experience. It will also encourage interaction, independence, self-confidence, exploration, and curiosity to help develop risk-taking skills in a safe and secure learning environment. This area will become an alternative learning space to the indoor facility and will work exceptionally well in providing an integrated facility where young children can experience creative learning and fun.

The current enrolment at the preschool is 23, however it has been considerably higher in recent years, and is projected to be higher again in coming years. The area is also used for Playgroup occasionally, and the adjacent Rural Care facility uses the grounds for its After School care program, and on non-preschool days, as well as integrating the Rural Care children into the Preschool program.

As you can imagine, this is a significantly large project in both scale and cost. So far we have received some funding from Cummins District Financial Services, and are in the process of applying for grant funding from a few other organisations. We also hope to write to other local businesses to give them, along with local families, the opportunity to play an important part in this redevelopment through monetary donations. **Would your business or family be willing to contribute something toward this project?** We do not have specific amounts in mind, and would be incredibly grateful for any donation large or small. For donations of \$1,000.00 or above, you will be acknowledged with a plaque that will be incorporated amongst the play area.

Alternatively, you could sponsor the purchase of a larger play item (starting at an estimated cost of \$3,500) such as:

- Tepee
- Trinet & Rope Traverse
- Puzzle Play Board
- Skill Tester Play Board
- Climbing Ramp

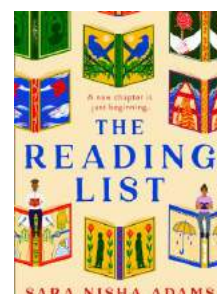

Any organisation or person may hire the pool.

A \$150 hiring fee is payable for the exclusive use of the pool which covers all attending and use of pool BBQ.

An extra \$60 hiring fee is payable for use of the kitchen/canteen area.

There must be a supervisor appointed who holds a current CPR or first aid certificate in attendance.

Hours available to hire are 10AM - 1.30PM weekends and from 6.15PM - 11PM any evening.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The swimming pool & its enclosure is a smoke free zone. No person shall be permitted to enter if under the influence of alcohol or drugs. No person shall enter the swimming pool unless the body and bathing suit are clean. No person shall permit any animal to enter the swimming pool or the swimming pool enclosure (penalty \$100). An ADULT must accompany and supervise children under the age of 10 at all times. No person shall cause suffering or permit boisterous behaviour in the pool, on the pathways, diving board or in the change rooms, showers or toilets. No person shall spit, blow their nose or urinate in the pool. In the event of lightning the pool must be cleared immediately. For safety reasons we ask that bikes be kept free of the concrete and paved areas at all times. Trespassers will be prosecuted.

The pool is provided for your enjoyment. However, any person who disobeys these conditions, behaves in a dangerous or offensive manner or refused to follow directions of pool staff WILL be asked to leave the pool with no refund.

COUNCIL NEWS

Coffin Bay cemetery

A gazebo has been installed at the



Coffin Bay cemetery and landscaping completed as part of the improvements planned for the Cemetery.

Chapman Road

Re-sheeting work has commenced along Chapman Road which will see piles of rubble stacked along the road from the Hyde Road intersection working south. To ensure the public and staff's safety, this section of road will be closed from October 21-26 (local residents will be able to access their properties but may experience delays). Thank you for your patience and understanding while Council makes these improvements.

Cummins Homes vacancy

Two one-bedroom units are currently available at Cummins Homes. If you or someone you know may be interested, please contact Council on 8676 0400.

North Shields beach access

Council have closed the current access at North Shields due to safety and environmental concerns and have been trying to establish a formalised vehicle access point further up from the 'no vehicles' zone for a number of years. Unfortunately after significant investment on environmental reports Council has not been able to gain approval from the Coast Protection Board however are working with the Board to identify a suitable access location.

New Community Grants open

Council has reinvigorated its 2021/22 Community Grants program to offer \$50,000 across three categories for individuals, community and sporting groups. A new Community Project Grant has a pool of \$43,000 available, with organisations welcome to apply for up to 50 per cent of a total project cost.

An Individual, Educational and Cultural Grant with a \$2000 pool is available to individuals to apply under the following criteria:

- \$100 for events held within South Australia

- \$500 for events held interstate
- \$1,000 for events held internationally

Council has also introduced a Community Halls Support Program, this year worth \$5000.

As part of the program Council will provide a maximum of 75 per cent of a total project cost. Any unallocated funds each year will be allocated to a Community Halls Reserve for future years applications.

Applications close at 12pm on Monday, November 8, 2021. Visit Council's website for an application form.

Big Swamp toilets

As part of the 2020/21 Community Grants, Council was able to assist the Big Swamp Community Centre with some funding for its toilet project and



are excited to see this has been completed! A huge congratulations goes to the committee and their volunteers, this was a massive amount of work but the end result looks fantastic and will provide the community with opportunities for more events and functions at the centre in the future. Well done everyone.

Kerbside recycling update

Residents of Cummins, Coffin Bay, Boston, Tiatukia, Tulka, Poonindie, North Shields and Louth Bay are currently receiving their yellow lid bin in time for kerbside recycling collection to begin in early November.

FAQs

Q: Where is the recycling waste going? The recycling will be processed to Port Lincoln for transport to Adelaide. Recycling will not go to landfill in the Eyre Peninsula.

Q: Can I choose not to recycle? Yes, you can elect not to put your yellow bin out, however the cost is included as a compulsory service charge in your rates. The more recycling becomes the normal standard, the cheaper it becomes and the less we add to landfill (which is great for the environment)!

Q: When is my yellow bin being picked up? The kerbside recycling is a fortnightly pickup with the pickup day depending on what town you are in.

- Coffin Bay/ Tulka: Tuesdays starting November 2.

- Cummins: Wednesdays starting November 3.

- Louth Bay/ Poonindie/ North Shields/ Tiatukia/ Boston: Tuesdays starting November 9.

Q: (Boston & Tulka Residents) - Why are my bins collected on different days? For most towns, recycling pickup is on the same day as the general waste pickup. Some towns (Tulka and parts of Boston) have different collection days for their red and yellow bins. Council has focused heavily on ensuring that kerbside recycling as cost efficient as possible, which has resulted in these different pickup days. For more information visit Council's website.
