# Latest news from the Coffin Bay SAAS Crew

In October five members of our Coffin Bay team were lucky enough to attend the SAAS Volunteer Conference in Whyalla. It was a jam-packed weekend with guest speakers talking about everything from palliative care to emergency medicine in Antarctica and the outback. We also had hands on scenarios in trauma, mental health and patient assessment. It was also a great chance to meet and learn from other volunteers and team leaders. We did get a little carried away during the SAAS Special Operations Team session, with Hannah hoisted up a tree and Sarah hanging out as a stretcher attendant while Lara, Ann and Kaye worked the ropes. Big thanks to Brian and Maz who held the fort in Coffins while we were away.



With the weather warming up our recent training sessions have centred around snake bite, allergies and anaphylaxis. We also refreshed our skills in haemorrhage control and recognising deterioration in patients. Sarah and Kaye took the ambulance on a visit to the Lake Wangary Preschool as part of their program of learning about how to keep themselves healthy and who in the community can help when someone is sick or injured.

Just a reminder, if you call on us in the next few months we will be wearing some extra PPE like masks, glasses and maybe also gowns and face shields – it's all part of keeping us and you safe. We're proud to be a local crew – it means we save people from having to wait for a response from Pt Lincoln. But we do need more members to fill all our roster gaps.



# The Coffin Bay Emergency Ready Committee would like to bring to your attention the trial of Alternative Voice Services being offered to resident of Coffin Bay and surrounds

There are a number of services being trialled across Australia to investigate alternative ways of delivering voice services in regional and remote areas. Whilst there are 260 trials going on only 2 have been chosen to trial the new Low Band Fixed Wireless solution –Coffin Bay and Robinvale (Vic).

CBERC considers this an important trial that residents should consider as it offers an alternative means of communication when power blackouts occur, and our town's communications go down with it.

When this service was being advertised it appears that some residents thought that it may have been a scam, or that there were hidden costs. We would like to reliably inform you that this is a legitimate service trial. Several of CBERC members have or are in the process of installing this service. We urge more residents to take up the trail which may support this potentially becoming a permanent service, offering residents an alternative means of communication in times of emergency. 



# **Gardening Tip**

by Phil Siviour Coffin Bay Gardening Service



Don't be fooled that your garden doesn't need watering if it's been raining. The secret to successful gardening, especially during summer, is to keep the roots of plants moist and cool. This can be achieved by having organic matter in the soil, mulch on top and using temporary shade during damaging heat. Remember to keep fruit trees well-watered as the crop grows.

If you haven't planted tomato seedlings yet, do it now in a garden bed that hasn't had a tomato crop for at least four years. If you have corn plants growing, build up the soil and mulch around the base of the plants for root growth and stability.

### ZERO WASTE / RECYCLING

A few lines to inspire people to tread lightly on this beautiful planet by Marianne Tremp

Yay! Our recycling bins have arrived!

Just a quick note about GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS. They can go into the recycling bin, as per the leaflet provided with the yellow lid bin BUT a better option is to recycle them at the local waste transfer station or take them to the \$0.10 recycling place (both for free). The reason for this is that glass will likely break in the compaction truck and contaminate the rest of the recycling. It can also be dangerous for the workers who sort through our recycled objects. The glass recycling place will take all glass off your hands, pre-sort it into colours and thereby enhance its reuse opportunities.

First collection in Coffin Bay will be Tuesday 2 November 2021 and fortnightly thereafter. Happy recycling!

# COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM

\$50,000 available across three new grant



### Community Grants

Council has reinvigorated its 2021/22 Community Grants program to offer \$50,000 across three categories for individuals, community and sporting groups. A new Community Project Grant will consist of broader eligibility criteria than the former Capital Grants program.

The Community Project Grant has a pool of \$43,000 available, with organisations welcome to apply for up to 50 per cent of a total project cost.

An Individual, Educational and Cultural Grant with a \$2000 pool is available to individuals to apply under the following criteria:

- · \$100 for events held within South Australia
- · \$500 for events held interstate
- · \$1,000 for events held internationally

Council has also introduced a Community Halls Support Program, this year worth \$5000.

As part of the program Council will provide a maximum of 75 per cent of a total project cost. Any unallocated funds each year will be allocated to a Community Halls Reserve for future years applications.

Applications close at 12pm on Monday, November 8, 2021. Forms and guidelines are available at https://www.lowereyrepeninsula.sa.gov.au/community-information/community-grants
