


Gardening Tip

by Phil Siviour Coffin Bay Gardening Service

Spikes of heat and hot northerly winds can be bad news for tomatoes. Shade cloth can drop the air temperature by as much as 15% during the day, so protect your plants this summer – white shade cloth is best.

If your fruit tree is loaded with heavy crops this year, fruit thinning will help produce a better crop for next year. Do this soon after the trees have completed their first natural dropping of fruit, usually 4-6 weeks after the fruit sets, which is about now.

.... And a final word for the year, mulch and water regularly over summer.






