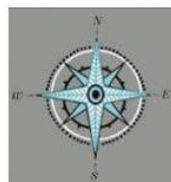

## Gardening Tip

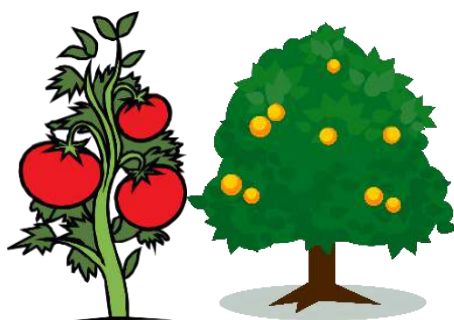

### *Coffin Bay Gardening Service*

Spikes of heat and hot northerly winds can be bad news for tomatoes. Shade cloth can drop the air temperature by as much as 15% during the day, so protect your plants this summer – white shade cloth is best.

If your fruit tree is loaded with heavy crops this year, fruit thinning will help produce a better crop for next year. Do this soon after the trees have completed their first natural dropping of fruit, usually 4 – 6 weeks after the fruit sets, which is about now.

.... And a final word for the year, mulch and water regularly over summer.
