

District Council of Lincoln Minutes of Meeting held on 21st January 1938

Present Crs Jas O'Shanahan (Chair) Jas Doudle, JC Harder, WG Morgan & CK Ritchie, also Clerk AH Taylor & Overseer KS McFarlane.

Minutes of previous meeting read & confirmed.

Financial statement presented showing Cr Bal of £818. 10. 4

Correspondence. Highways Dept advising that the reconstruction of Bridge on West Main Road at Sections 137 & 139 Hd Warrow has been completed with formal notice of same in terms of Highways Act.

Highways Dept advising that Director of Lands intimates that the necessary survey for defining the road boundary north of Sec 12 Hd Kiana will be undertaken in February 1938.

Director Local Govt advising that the necessary notice in connexion with proposed subdivision of Mortlock & Mitchell Wards into Three Wards appeared in Govt Gazette of 30. 12. 37 and stating that Council should have a copy of said notice published in a Local paper circulating in the District.

Highways Dept advising that the sum apportioned this Council as Grant-in-aid for the present financial year to £265. with form of application for same attached. Clerk reported having completed the application and posted same.

Highways Dept advising that the construction of a culvert at about 15 miles from Port Lincoln on North Main Road would

Heavy loads on Roads - Clerk was instructed to write to the Highways Dept pointing out that the heavy loads being carried on Motor Trucks is damaging the Bitumen on the North Road, and ask what what can be done in the way of restricting the weight of loads.

Minutes of meeting held on 18th February 1938

Cr Morgan took the Chair. (Clerk AH. Taylor & Overseer KS McFarlane also present) Financial Statement Presented showing Cr Bal on General a/c of £950.9.5., Machinery A/c £232.6.2 & Fencing Loans £148.5.5

Correspondence Highways Dept stating that the cost of the necessary cutting & banking at meadows Creek on Main EP. Road be a charge against Federal Aid grant of £1500 allotted on 15.11.37. Highways Dept in reply to Councils letter in reference to maximum loading, and pointing out that this is governed by Part IV of Roads Traffic Act, 1934-36. For the enforcement of which it is necessary for the Council to appoint an Authorized Officer in accordance with Section 95 of the Act. K.S. McFarlane was appointed Authorized Officer under the Roads Traffic Act 1934-36. (Prop Cr. Ritchie, Sec Cr. Harder) Inspector General of Hospitals advising that the amount of Contribution due by this Council under Hospitals Act 1934 towards Port Lincoln Hospital for Current Financial Year is £147.12.2. Minutes of Meeting held on 22nd April 1938

Present Crs WG Morgan (Chair) Jas Doudle. RF Richardson & CK Ritchie also Clerk AH Taylor & Overseer KS McFarlane. Clerk reported that at the Extraordinary Election By Ballot for one Councillor for Louth Ward Mr. R.F. Richardson was duly elected. Minutes of previous meeting read & confirmed also of Special meeting.

Financial Statement Presented. Strong Cr Balance of £2152. 2. 11 on General a/c. Correspondence:- Highway Dept . in reply to letter re the need of a Bridge across Charlton Creek at Section 139 Hd Louth, requesting that approximate measurements of proposed Bridge and estimated cost of same. In the event of Half the cost of being provided would Council undertake to construct the Bridge. It was resolved that as the Council have no funds available, nothing can be done at present. Highways Dept Submitted a list of pipes required for Culverts on Main EP Road No 8 as approved, and to be a charge against the Federal Aid Grant of £1500 allotted for this financial year. Clerk reported that the pipes have been ordered Highways Dept. Two letters, the first notifying that no CounterPetition had been lodged objecting to the re subdivision of Mortlock & Mitchell Wards and the second letter drawing attention to the Proclamation in Govt Gazette of 7th April declaring the above divided into Mortlock Ward \_ Ulipa Ward and Shannon Ward with one Councillor for each Ward.

Correspondence (Contd) Highways Dept, in reference to Councils application of Special Grant of £300 for roads in Mortlock Ward and stating that it is regretted that funds for this financial year are fully committed. The application will receive favourable consideration when additional funds are voted for next financial year and Vouchers submitted after July 1st next will be recouped. Highways Dept - Stating that funds for assisting Councils to purchase machinery are all committed but that if application for an advance to obtain an approved type of 1 ½ Ton Truck giving full particulars of make, size, type, and cost of same early next financial year. Same will receive favourable consideration. Highways Dept Advising that approved gravel may be substituted for metal on Main West Road No 9 (near Warrow).

Highways Dept Stating that the erection of Ramps on important Main Roads is to be discouraged, but that under the Circumstances attaching to this particular case, no objection will be raised to the Council leasing the road to JS Phillips in terms of Section 375 of LG Act 1934 and that a 20 foot Ramp would more likely to be allowed to remain than would a smaller one. Moved by Cr Richardson that Clerk write the Highways Dept for specification of ramps as required for heavy traffic on main highways - Sec Cr Doudle, Carried Highways Dept Advising that repairs to bitumen on Freezing Works Road would be commenced about 15th April. Highways Dept with formal notice of completion of Bridge at Coult Creek on 19th March 1938.

Director of Lands with copy of Annual Licence granted to Mr RF Poole to occupy for camping purposes ¼ acre of Crown Lands facing Kellidie Bay.

Prop Cr Morgan that the advice of Councils Solicitor be obtained in reference to Licencee letting Shack on the land leased. Sec Cr Ritchie, Carried Director of Lands advising that Similar Annual Licences had been granted to PJ Gibson, J Eglinton, KS McFarlane & HR Phillips. State Bank of SA Stating amounts due by Council on account of Netting and Fencing Loans as at 7th April 1938.

Late Chairman, Cr Jas O'Shanahan - Letter of Sympathy received from the following - Corporation of Port Lincoln - District Council of LeHunte and EP Local Government Association. Prop Cr Morgan that letters of thanks be sent to each of these, Sec Cr Doudle, Carried Industrial Dispute Secy EP Local Govt Association wrote in reference to Wages Log submitted by A.W.U. to C/Wealth Arbitration Court and asking to be advised on Councils wishes as to being represented when the case is called on in Adelaide Moved by Cr Ritchie that this Council is in favor of EP Local Govt Association being represented to give evidence on behalf of the Councils in the Association. Sec Cr Richardson - Carried Anzac Day Holiday- Secy EP Local Govt Assoc wrote stating that at the last conference held at Cowell a recommendation was passed in favor of Anzac Day being recognised as a Paid Holiday to all employees, but it was left to each Council to make their own decision on the matter Prop Cr Ritchie that Anzac Day be a paid holiday to all employees of this Council. Sec Cr Richardson , Carried

Government Produce Dept wrote asking permission to erect New High Tension Main on the opposite side of the Proper Bay Road to the existing lines, on completion of which the present line will be removed . Granted

Darkey WH wrote in reference to damage done to his buckboard which he states was caused through a wash out in the road near Karkoo and asking Council to reimburse him for damage done. Clerk to reply that the washout was evidently caused by heavy rain and not the fault of the Council. Therefore they are not to be held responsible. Robinson AA Requested that bushes be grubbed that are on the road from the Brick Kiln to his gate. Also that repairs be done to the road at the approach to his ramp as this has been washed out. Resolved that the road be repaired but as the bushes are not interfering with the traffic on the road, the grubbing cannot be done at present. Young CW Requested that the road from Section 351 and 430 Hd Louth to Secs 42 & 54 Hd Wanilla be grubbed which would give him an entrance to Sections 42 & 43 Hd Wanilla, which he has recently purchased. Also that the road on the north boundary of Sections 42 & 43 be pegged out so that he can fence the north boundary of the sand sections Resolved that when his Transfer goes through the grubbing will be again considered and that the defining of the boundary of his Sections is not the duty of the Council - No doubt the Survey Pegs are there to show the boundary. Bryant WE Wildeloo requested that 12 ft of 6" concrete pipes be supplied by Council, which he would place in position and cover with rubble in front of the entrance to his property in Light Road Cummins. Granted

O'Dea WM applied for an advance of £20 on account of work in making a New assessment for the District - portion of the assessment having been completed and delivered to the Clerk - On a motion by Cr Ritchie Sec by Cr Doudle this was granted and cheque £20 drawn.

Director of Local Government drew attention to Petition of C & N Wade in Govt Gazette of 24/11/38 requesting that Thistle Island be severed from Lincoln Dist Council Area. Proposed Cr Ritchie, That as Council are not in agreement with the area being severed from Council's jurisdiction, as this would cause a precedent that a Counter Petition be forwarded to the Minister objecting to the said severance. Sec Cr Smith. Carried. Reserve. Director of Local Govt / Copy of letter to Sanders, Nullon & Campbell, Stating that their request had been granted and Reserve in Lincoln View had been transferred from Corporation of Pt Lincoln Area. Revenue/ Director of Local Govt wrote pointing out what constitutes Revenue in determining overdrafts limitation under Section 449 of L. G Act 1934. Noxious Weeds on Crown Land./ Commr of Taxes wrote Stating that as Section 433 & 434 Hd Lincoln, are now Crown Lands.
