Community Grant recipients

Council has awarded a total of \$55,482 as part of its 2020/21 Community Grants program to six local organisations and clubs.

Extra funding above the two \$25,000 pools was available this year due to a successful 2019/20 grant no longer being required by the Coult Water Scheme – freeing up an extra \$6,250.

The following bodies will receive Community Capital Support Grants:-

Big Swamp Community Centre - \$10,500 to construct a toilet block; United Yeelanna Football Club- \$15,000 to construct an children's activity and storage room; Point Boston Community Corporation Inc - \$15,000 to repurpose the obsolete water facility building into a community meeting place; Cummins Tennis Club - \$3,348 for rewiring/lighting upgrade at Cummins courts; and the Coffin Bay Progress Association - \$3,334 for a swimming pontoon.

The Cummins and District Tourism Committee was granted \$8,300 as part of the Community Reserves Support Grants to put towards the Cummins township entrance sign project for a sign at the southern entrance from Tod Highway.

Mayor Jo-Anne Quigley said it was encouraging to see so many high quality, worthy applicants from across a wide section of our Council district.

“Council is once again impressed by the community spirit that leads to people wanting to improve their organisations facilities.”

All project are to be completed within the next year.
