PRESIDENTS REPORT

Hello Coffin Bay,

Someone recently said that they thought it was time for Progress to move on from the Hall and do more in the Community, I bit my tongue and that was very hard for me to do.

The Community Hall is the Community and has been for 50 years and in our Constitution it states that it is our responsibility to manage the property, know as the CB Community Hall. For many years it was the hub of the town where people met for suppers, dancing, weddings, parties and it was used for concerts that were often fund raisers for Community projects eg the Ambulance station. In 2013 my girlfriends & I used the Hall twice, raising money for Varsity, the children's charity when we were fortunate enough to be part of the Varsity BASH, a real Bucket List moment for us.

Over the decades other places opened, the sporting club, yacht club and the hotel and things changed for the Hall and it wasn't used as much by the Community.

Many rural towns have Halls but you can tell that they are neglected and no longer in use, we are one of the fortunate Communities to still have our Hall open and used. When I became the President 2 years ago I remember standing in the middle of the Hall by myself and pictured the Hall full of people and activities.

We have made some upgrades and there is still more to do, some cosmetic and some major, we are still waiting to hear if our latest grant application has been successful, this money will be spent on the Halls roof and ceiling repairs, if these repairs can't be carried out in the near future then use of the Hall could be compromised.

Our Community Hall has never been used as much as it is right now and this is exciting to see.

And then it's used for monthly Markets, this year it has been hired by the Fisheries and Rose Club for meetings and there was a Adventure Driver Training course held, the local Mosaic group held a magnificent exhibition of their work earlier this year and a highly successful Trash & Treasure weekend was held to raise funds for the pontoons. Wangary School recently camped overnight in the Hall, Christmas church services and a Christmas Party were held and just recently the ANZAC Dawn service.

The Library not only has a great selection of books available in the Hall but also online and on the last Tuesday of the month the Red Cross is there to give you assistance and information to access the Red Cross support service, digital support is also available, call 86762476 to make an appointment for either of these services.

For all of the above to take place Progress have to raise funds to pay the bills and keep the hall open and rely on Grants for major works and this is not easy for such a small group to do, in fact it's dam hard work.

Gardening Tip

Broadbeans may be planted this month. They are a very nutritious vegetable that contains protein, and have the added benefit of replenishing nitrogen in the soil. May is also the ideal month to plant onions. Asian greens also grow well through winter, especially in raised beds or containers.

Tidy strawberry plants by removing any old leaves and unwanted runners, then renew the mulch.

Just when you thought you were on top of warm season weeds, the autumn ones pop up! Don't ignore your weeds or they will get out of control – come up with a management plan and stick to it. 20 minutes once a week could be all it takes.

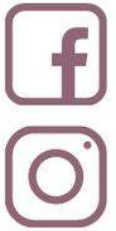
A few lines to inspire people to tread lightly on this beautiful planet

ALUMINIUM – With Easter last month, we have collected a lot of foil wrappings! We usually put all foil in a coffee mug until there is enough to scrunch up and put in our recycling bin. See below an article I copied from a Facebook page:

“Save all of your foil wrapping and roll it into a ball (similar to a tennis ball size) pop it in the recycling bin. The great news is Australia is all over aluminium recycling. In fact aluminium foil can be made into so many practical products and more importantly it saves the most energy, meaning we don't need to mine to get more aluminium. In Australia it is usually made back into more aluminium.”

In this photo we've collected the foil in a pie dish (because we ate a lot of chocolate at Easter!). As long as it is clean it is good to recycle. Wine bottle caps, ring pull caps, tealight moulds etc. How do you know whether it is aluminium? If it sticks to a magnet, pop it in the METAL recycling, which I'll be talking about next month.

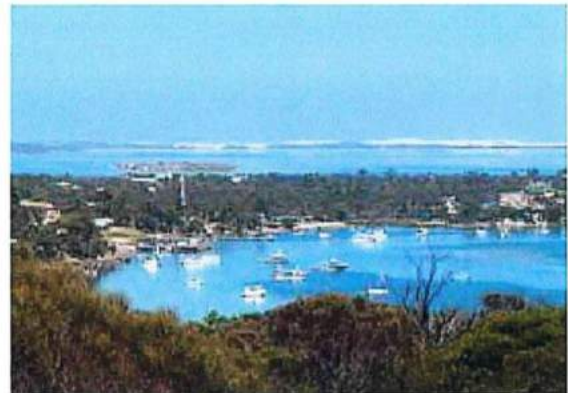
