Those flying more recently to, and from, the Port Lincoln Airport will have noticed an increased frequency in changes to flight times and sometimes, cancellations.

The Port Lincoln Airport is a critical piece of community and economic infrastructure, and Lower Eyre Council greatly values the community's patronage and use of the carrier services offered as an efficient, quick way to connect with Adelaide and the nation.

Lower Eyre Council Chief Executive Officer Delfina Lanzilli said recent enquiry to Rex Airlines revealed the complex environment the aviation sector was dealing with as it rebounded from the past two years of Covid19-caused disruption, which is currently resulting in less aircraft available in the network to service the Port Lincoln / Adelaide route as well as other regional routes.

Ms Lanzilli said to minimise disruption and avoid further disappointment Council strongly suggests regularly checking with the airlines for changes to schedules, and prior to attending the airport, to ensure your flight details are as up to date as possible.

"Lower Eyre Council continues to work closely with both Rex Airlines and Qantas to ensure the best service possible to the Eyre Peninsula community and business sector," Ms Lanzilli said.
