Minutes of Meeting held 18th January 1936

Present Councillors Jas OShanahan (Chairman) Jas Doudle, JC Harder, WG Morgan , & CK Ritchie AH Taylor Clerk ,& RS McFarlane Overseer. Minutes of previous meeting read & confirmed.

Financial Statement Submitted. Correspondence.

High & Local Govt Wrote in reply to letter of 23rd Dec in reference to reconstruction work and stated that the Council may expect a Special grant of £1000 being made in April next for construction of a loose gravel surface on West Main Road and a further grant of the same amount during the next financial year for the same purpose. The annual contribution required in regard to such constructed roads will be determined at the time of the allocation approximately about £5 per mile per annum.

Highways & L Govt Stating that as the amount voted by Parliament for this financial year for roads generally has been allotted, the Commissioner is unable to grant the request for £200 to repair the road to Coffin Bay.

Correspondence (Contd) Highways & Local Govt Advising that the the £50 reserved for maintenance & dragging loose gravel on West Main Road _ may be spent on other Main Roads at the discretion of the Council. And also that it is desired that the Council Continues to maintain and drag the gravelled Section as at present out of District Funds and Claim for reimbursement, in the usual way.

Highways & Local Govt Pointing out that in many cases, graded & brattenized Roads on E Pen are being seriously damaged by a limited number of carters, carrying maximum loads, and suggesting that the EP Local Govt give attention to a proposal to reduce the weight per inch of Tyre as has been done by the Dist Councils in the Murray Lands as published in Govt Gazette of 3/10/35.

Highways & Local Govt Pointing out the regulation in Govt Gazette of 19/12/35 prescribing the form of reflector that may be used in substitution for lights required to be fixed on barriers across roads under repair.

Highway & Local Govt Drawing attention to the Noxious Weeds Amendment Act No 2736 of 1935. And that an illustrated bulletin is in course of preparation by the Dept of Agriculture describing the Noxious Weeds and means most suitable for their eradication.

Inspector General of Hospitals Notifying that the amount required from this Council as Contribution to the Port Lincoln Hospital under the Rating Act for the period ending 30/6/36 is £140. 10. 4 to be paid on or before 28th Febry 1936.

Highway & Local Govt that the Amount of £239 as Grant-in-Aid had been paid to the credit of the Council on 24/18/35.

Resolved that the Clerk write to Inspector General Stating that the Council consider the amount is excessive & ask if it cannot be reduced & state that as a whole the Ratepayers of the District Council use the Hospital less than the Ratepayers of the P.L. Corporation and yet the Council is rated considerably higher

and also state that we are rated higher this year than last year & ask the reason of the increase.

Highways & Local Govt In reference to Bush Fires Amendment Act No 2258 of 1935

HG Haines in Reference to Rate notice and stating that his lease of Sec 35 Hd Mitchell was cancelled in Novr 1934 and he has not occupied it since that date & therefore is not responsible for Rates. Resolved that the Clerk make the necessary alterations in the assessment book.

Minutes of previous meeting read & confirmed.

Financial Statement presented.

Correspondence Highways & Local Govt in reference to Advertising Signs erected on roads, and requesting the Co operation of the Council by having same removed and prohibiting the erection of others. Resolved that the erection of Advertising Signs be prohibited on the roads in the District of the Council.

H & L Govt In reference with copy of request from C Wade. Thistle Island to have the Island severed from the District Council Area. It was resolved that the Council cannot recommend the severence.

Highways Dept Stating that no funds are avaiable for extending the brattenising on West Main Road as requested.

Under Secretary Stating the Chief Secretary regrets that no funds are available at present for improving the road to the South Coast.

Secretary to Inspector General of Hospitals re Hospital Rating and ointing out that the Councils contribution is based on a rate of .94 of a penny in the £ on the Assessment.

LN Firth Cummins requesting that 30 chains of metalling be done on road through Section 13 Hd Cummins- Resolved that this cannot be done at present.

E Whitlock Jones. Advising that LG Minhard and himself had agreed to divide Section 7S Hd Cummins and each take half of the land and requesting that the Fencing loans theron be equally proportioned. Clerk stated that he had replied to Mr Jones Stating that written applications on account of each loan each signed by both himself & Mr Minhard will be required - and that these have not yet been received.

RCF. Lear to Cr Morgan Stating that Bush Huts and Sanitary arrangements are necessary at Coffins Bay to cope with Campers at that locality, & stating that if he had more land granted to him he would attend to same. Correspondence St John's Wort - Highways Dept wrote in reference to St John's Wort on Section 433 .434 Hd Lincoln. Received Green Patch Agricultural Bureau suggesting that the Council call a meeting of Landholders and the Corporation of Pt Lincoln to consider the best means of deal with this weed.

Received. Corporation of Pt Lincoln also wrote in reference to this weed & the clerk was instructed to reply that the Council have been dealing with this matter for the last 12 months and have had considerable trouble in having it destroyed, particularly on property that the Corporation had allowed the weed to spread prior to handing over to the Council.

Maximum weight of load on Vehicles. The Highways Dept stating that it was considered advisable for uniform conditions, as to maximum loading. Should apply to all Districts on Eyre Peninsula and asking if the Council would be favourable.

Correspondence (Contd) for such a regulation to apply to this District.
