Leadership Effort Achieve Respect Nurture

THE COFFIN BAY MASTER PLAN - HOW MUCH RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT DO WE NEED?

This article has been written and authorised for publication by Cr Alan Tingay. It contains his personal opinions on some parts of the Coffin Bay Master Plan. It should not be assumed that the District Council of Lower Eyre Peninsula or other Councillors share these opinions.

The draft Master Plan for Coffin Bay will be released for public review and comment on the 28th of June. It's very important that residents carefully consider and comment on this plan as it will shape the development of Coffin Bay for many years to come.

In my opinion, the most important issue for the Master Plan is the potential for urban growth in our town. It's important because the quality of life and the appearance of the town that we currently enjoy are due in large part to our relatively small population and the remnant vegetation that is present in many areas. It follows that as the population grows, as it inevitably will, at some point the quiet town atmosphere, the lifestyle and the remnant vegetation will be eroded and may disappear altogether. There is a substantial risk that Coffin Bay will become an overcrowded coastal resort with dense housing on small blocks.

The challenge for the Master Plan then is how to contain this potential growth. One obvious way is to try to limit the ultimate size of the population through the availability of residential land. According to the last census the resident population of Coffin Bay is a little over 600. It is suggested in the Master Plan that this could grow to about 800 (a 30% increase) without causing an unacceptable impact. This equates to about 80 new houses based on an occupancy rate of 2.5 persons per house. The current demand for vacant lots for new houses is a little under 8 per year which means that it may take 10 years for the resident population to reach 800.

The planners who are preparing the Master Plan estimate that there is sufficient land zoned residential in Coffin Bay to meet the current demand for housing for 50 years. There is the potential therefore for the population of the town to greatly exceed 800 residents. Even if some of this land never comes onto the market or is not developed for environmental or other reasons, there is likely to be much more than sufficient land for development for many years.

Despite this analysis the Master Plan also includes the potential expansion of the Angasi Shores residential estate which according to the Concept Plan of its owners, could provide about 80 more blocks. In other words this development alone could provide the predicted demand for 80 new house lots over the next 10 years.

The draft Master Plan therefore is contradictory – it aspires to limit the population but at the same time includes a substantial potential increase in residential land. In my opinion, this contradiction needs to be resolved in the final Master Plan.

We could leave the supply of land including the Angasi Shores development to market forces and forget about a target population as a critical factor affecting liveability. In which case why bother to prepare a Master Plan at all. Or alternatively, we could plan for new housing and population growth only on the existing residential zoned land and remove from the Plan proposals that would increase the supply of residential blocks. These proposals include not only the expansion of Angasi Shores but also Lot 669 which is located on the Esplanade between Lear Street and Jubilee Drive.

Lot 669 land is owned by the District Council which has development approval for a row of house lots along the Esplanade. It intends to sell these in order to raise revenue. This will completely change the street-scape in this area. Lot 669 is thickly vegetated at present and much of this vegetation would be removed. There would be issues relating to access and probably traffic management and the Jubilee Road reserve would need to be widened. The question is whether this is the best use of this land.

Furthermore, a "Lifestyle Village" is proposed behind the row of houses. In effect the result would be high density residential. Residents of Coffin Bay support the inclusion of a retirement village in the Master Plan but this is a completely different concept to what is likely to be proposed. I suggest as an alternative that it would be better to set Lot 669 aside in the Master Plan for appropriate future Community Uses, as it is strategically located near the centre of town and is owned by the District Council of Lower Eyre Peninsula. There is no other equivalent parcel of land in Coffin Bay.

I emphasise again that the Coffin Bay Master Plan is a critical document that will influence planning decisions for years to come and will determine whether the essential values of our town are recognised and preserved. I urge you all to get a copy, to consider its implications carefully, and to make your views known during the public review period.

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




