We meet for our regular monthly workdays on the last Monday of the month and other workdays as required. Check us out on eleptroastcare to stay up to date with our current projects and workdays.


On the last Monday we meet at the Coffin Bay boat ramp BBQ area, 8.30 am. Visitors most welcome.

The Lower Eyre Coastcare Association is very excited to be hosting events for the Nature Festival SA in Coffin Bay. The festival theme is "The nature of home" and we want to celebrate the wonders of nature around Coffin Bay by inviting you to experience art, photography, multimedia displays and walks in nature to learn a little more about the nature around us.

Our events in Coffin Bay will run from Friday 13th-Sunday 15th October with the main event taking place on Long Beach on Saturday 14th for World Migratory Bird Day when a colourful flock of birds, migratory and resident shorebirds, painted by our community will be installed on the beach.

The art installation will be an opportunity to get to know some of the shorebirds that fly in from the other side of the

world to spend the summer on our beaches and to get to know a bit more about our local resident shorebirds. We invite you to take a walk amongst the fantastic flamboyant flock to pick up some identification tips, then take a walk further along the beach and try to spot the real birds who have already flown in for the summer (don't forget your binoculars).

Also on Long Beach on Saturday 14th professional photographer Fran Solly and members of the Port Lincoln Camera Club will be guiding walks along the beach for "Photographing the nature of our home" offering tips and tricks on photographing birds and nature including ethical bird photography (free event but booking required as numbers strictly limited).



Long Beach will be closed to vehicles for the day to allow for visitor safety and the installation of the art display. Other activities starting from Long Beach include the Wild Yarnbala tours, a guided walk through nearby native intact vegetation and an opportunity to view bush birds, forage for bush foods and more.

The Coffin Bay Hall will be the venue for the "Through the Lens" multimedia display of the nature around Coffin Bay and will run Friday 13th- Sunday 15 October, 10-4. Exhibitors include the Southern Eyre Bird

Group, Lake Wangary School will showcase their Minya Custodians program, the Friends of the Osprey will update on the travels of ospreys being tracked, reptiles of Eyre Peninsula from Australia's Reptiles for All, underwater photography from Manny Katz (Coffin Bay Scuba Co), dive with the cuttlefish with the virtual reality headsets (available Friday afternoon only), Arj Slater's first exhibition of his bird photography, with more exhibitors being added. Entry by gold coin donation to the Friends of the Osprey.



The Lake Wangary School will be a hosting a sausage sizzle fundraiser in the Long beach carpark on the Saturday and the icecream van will be on site too.





LONG BEACH WITH PARTICULAR REFERENCE TO PIED OYSTERCATCHERS

There is an international treaty known as the Ramsar Convention which aims to halt the world-wide degradation of wetlands with resulting great losses of waterbirds, and to preserve "through wise use and management" those that remain. 169 countries are signatories including Australia. The Convention contains 9 criteria, and meeting one or more qualifies a site to be recognized of international importance. Criterion 6 stipulates that a site qualifies if it regularly holds 1% of a species of waterbird.

Since 2011, through regular surveying, it has been discovered that Long Beach annually averages a very significant 2% of the estimated world population of Pied Oystercatchers, species Haemotopus longirostris. In March 2012, 267 birds were counted, and is, as far as I can ascertain, one of the largest flocks ever recorded. The Environment Department has acknowledged in a letter that the beach qualifies to be recognized of world importance.

Pied Oystercatchers roost when the flooding tide inundates their feeding grounds. Flocks have been observed flying from Yangie Bay, Point Longnose, Dutton Bay and Kelledie Bay to roost during high tide at Long Beach.



Spring is the usual breeding time for Pied Oystercatchers. The nest, with 2 to 3 eggs is a scrape in the sand above the high tide mark. It takes 9 weeks from the laying of the eggs for the hatchlings to fledge (fly). Mortality rates are very high (gulls, cats, foxes and crushing by 4WD's). By late summer, the fledglings have become independent. It coincides with the Long Beach flock reaching maximum numbers.


The young birds appear rather diffident on joining the flock and are usually found on the edges. They can be distinguished by their pale legs, dark beak and brown

Counting the young birds can give an indication of yearly number of successfully fledged birds in the Coffin Bay area. Since 2016, the biggest count has been eight. These low numbers are of concern. Their lifespan is around 25 years and a count of at least ten fledglings would seem to be needed to maintain the Coffin Bay population. More field data is needed on this subject. .





At the western end of the beach there is a large area of samphire. It takes decades to fully recover from heavy damage. Four species of heron are often seen fishing here. The Pied Oystercatchers shelter in this samphire during storms, perhaps because they have some protection from the wind and early sighting of predators such as foxes and cats. Here they wait it out; storm tides flood access to food and they have great difficulty flying.







In 2008, much of the beach was covered by vast areas of Anapella cycladea cockles. They grow to 30mm and inhabit the upper reaches of the intertidal zone. In summer of that year, 782 cockles were counted in one sq. metre of sand.

The second photo of the same area was taken twelve years after. The richness of life in the upper tidal zone has been mostly destroyed. It was a valuable food source for shorebirds, including Pied Oystercatchers.


